Dialogue With a Collection: Kim Carlino is part of a series at the University Museum of Contemporary Art in which invited local artists exhibit their own artworks in juxtaposition with pieces they select from the museum's permanent collection of more than 3000 contemporary prints, drawings, and photographs. This exhibition offers a rare opportunity to showcase artworks owned by UMass and provides a platform for a local artist to present her work. Kim Carlino is an emerging artist in our community.

Kim Carlino is an artist and independent curator who lives and works in Easthampton, MA. Carlino received her BFA from the UMass Amherst. She also studied at the New School and Drawing Room in New York. Carlino was a member of the team of artists who installed the 25-year Retrospective of Sol LeWitt's Wall Drawings at MASS MoCA in North Adams, MA. She has exhibited her paintings, drawing, woodcuts, and installations in solo and group exhibitions throughout western Massachusetts and has been part of group shows in New York City and Boston.
